Drug Labeling in the Procedural Setting: Best Practices (1)

Ambulatory surgery centers should label all drugs according to ASC policy. This includes, but is not limited to those:

- Used in the perioperative and other procedural settings
- Used on and off of the sterile field
- Not used immediately

Other best practices include, but are not limited to:

- Label any drug when it is transferred from the original packaging to another container
- Verify all labels both verbally and visually
- Use a two-person verification process if the drug is prepared and administered by different people
- Label all drugs as soon as they are prepared, unless immediately administered
- Discard any unlabeled drugs
- Remove all labeled containers at the conclusion of a procedure
